EXAMS

Ballet, Modern & Tap exams will take place mid-late November – exact dates to be confirmed as soon as they are known.

The showcase will take place on the 12th & 13th December at the Create Theatre in Mansfield (attached to Mansfield College). All vocal students will be involved as well as all students from Grade 2 modern/ballet upwards. Children in Pre-school, Pre-Primary, Primary & Grade 1 classes will have their performance at the studio on the morning of the 12th December (last Saturday of term). CHOREOGRAPHIC COMPETITION

Anyone wanting to submit choreography for the Winter showcase can enter our 'in house choreographic competition' with the possibility of showcasing their own work at the theatre in December. More details to follow.
